KYA - SIGN UP!

- We strongly encourage **ALL RESIDENTS** to sign up for Kya if possible.

GROCERY BUS

- We are temporarily discontinuing grocery bus service. **The last trip will be on Friday, March 27th.** Please plan accordingly.
- We are in the process of developing a grocery program to help residents that need assistance. If you need help with groceries, please call the Switchboard (x0) or email groceries@panorama.org for more information.

ACCESS TO THE APARTMENT BUILDINGS

Effective Thursday, March 26th

- All doors to the three apartment buildings will be locked **at all times** and residents of the building will need their key to gain entry. Egress will still be possible at all doors.
- Only building residents and Essential Service Providers (ESPs) will be granted access to the apartment buildings. An ESP is defined as a caregiver or a housekeeper. **No other visitors are permitted.**
- All ESPs will need to go to the Auditorium Lobby for screening between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm, seven days a week. They will be allowed access to the apartment buildings following screening.
- **For after hours visits:** Any resident who is expecting a caregiver or housekeeper after hours should make sure they know to check in with the on-duty Urgent Response Aide (360)413-6000.
- Food and grocery deliveries for apartment building residents will also be directed to the Auditorium Lobby for screening. A Panorama employee will deliver the food to your door.
- Panorama staff will facilitate all package and newspaper deliveries for building residents.

ACCESS TO PANORAMA HALL

Effective Thursday, March 26th

- All doors to Panorama Hall will be locked except for the entrance located in the parking lot by Puget Pharmacy.
- This entrance will be open between Monday - Friday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm for patrons of Timberland Bank and the Pharmacy only. **No other visitors are permitted.**
- Everyone entering this building will be subject to a screening including a sign-in procedure and a temperature check at the door.
- Timberland Bank hours are Monday-Friday from 10:00 am- 3:00 pm until further notice.
- Puget Pharmacy Hours are Monday-Friday from 9:30 am to 5:00 pm until further notice.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

We are working hard to protect our community from the risks of exposure and to do our part to prevent the spread of this virus state-wide. The most powerful effort we can make as individuals is maintaining social distancing. We have received many reports of residents gathering on campus. We **implore** you all to adhere to the following guidelines:

- **NO** gathering in common spaces
- **NO** gathering outdoors (dog park, pea patch, etc..)
- Please **stay home**
- If a visit is necessary, please stay 6 feet away from others at all times.

STAFF AND OFFICE VISITS

VISITORS IN THE CONVALESCENT CENTER AND ASSISTED LIVING

- To protect our staff and residents from the risk of exposure to COVID-19, the C&R and Assisted Living are **closed to visitors**.
- This measure is temporary and will be continuously evaluated as the global COVID-19 situation evolves.
- Our residents' ability to connect with their loved ones continues to be of vital importance and we have established ways for residents of Assisted Living and the C&R to video chat with family.
