



Community Health Update - January 21, 2021

C&R EMPLOYEE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

An employee from the Convalescent & Rehabilitation Center has tested positive for COVID-19. On 1/14, the employee learned they were exposed to the virus through a family member. Per protocol, they have not been in the C&R nor have they had any contact with residents or staff since they learned of the exposure. The employee decided to get tested on Monday (1/18) when they began experiencing symptoms. They reported the positive result to us yesterday afternoon.

We continue to test all C&R staff and residents on a weekly basis as required for all skilled nursing facilities in our area. Our last testing event was conducted on Monday 1/18. All resident results are negative. All staff results received thus far are negative, with 10 staff tests still pending.

The Convalescent & Rehabilitation Center has been placed under "Public Health Monitoring" as determined by the Department of Health. In addition to the precautions our C&R has already implemented, the additional control measures require us to temporarily pause admissions until the Public Health Monitoring period has ended. This 14-day monitoring period will end on 1/30 if no other staff or residents test positive.

VACCINE INFORMATION UPDATES

C&R residents received their first dose of the vaccine as part of Washington State's Phase 1a. Their second dose is scheduled for February 2nd and 3rd.

Assisted Living residents received their first dose yesterday.

Independent Living residents in the Quinault and the Chalet received their first dose of the vaccine yesterday. Some Chinook residents also received their first dose, as the CVS immunizers had leftover doses. The remainder of Chinook residents will be prioritized at the next on-campus vaccination opportunity.
