



## Community Health Update - January 23, 2021

### COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINIC SCHEDULED FOR WEDNESDAY 1/27

In collaboration with the Washington National Guard, the Washington State Department of Health, and the Thurston County Public Health Department, we have secured a vaccination opportunity for the remainder of our campus this coming Wednesday. This clinic provides an opportunity for **all Panorama residents and staff who have not yet been vaccinated to receive their first dose**. The Moderna vaccine will be administered by National Guard medical personnel.

The registration and consent process for this clinic is different from that of our previous clinics. The State has developed a paperless system that does not require copies of insurance cards. However, it is crucial that everyone who is interested in receiving their vaccination at this clinic be registered before Wednesday.

Our records\* indicate we have approximately 650 residents who have not received the vaccine (whether on campus or off campus). Those 650 residents will receive an email today (or phone call for those who do not use email), offering the choice to participate in Wednesday's clinic.

By Monday morning, all residents who signed up will receive registration instructions. Those who did not respond will receive a phone call. Staff will ensure all residents on the list of 650 have the opportunity and assistance needed to register.

*\*If you have received the vaccine off campus and have not yet reported this to Panorama, the forthcoming email survey will provide you with an opportunity to let us know so we don't call you on Monday.*

This will be the first vaccination clinic the State and the National Guard have coordinated with a retirement community. While all agencies involved in this effort are confident it will move forward, we must report the remote possibility that it could be canceled in the event the State cannot procure the specialty coolers required to transport the vaccine doses to our campus. In the unlikely event that the clinic is canceled, we will notify the community via a Community Health Update.

### CAMPUS IMPACTS

The clinic will take place in Pan Hall and the restaurant. **Due to the large scope of this effort, social distancing requirements, and parking limitations, we are asking all residents to avoid unnecessary trips to Pan Hall on Wednesday.**

**Seventeen51 Restaurant & Bistro will be closed on Wednesday 1/27.** Heat & Serve meals ordered by Monday 1/25, will still be delivered on Wednesday 1/27.
