



Community Health Update - January 15, 2021

VACCINATION CLINIC DATE CHANGED

Today we received word from CVS that they have rescheduled our January 30th vaccination clinic to **January 20th**. CVS changed their strategy as a result of our advocacy efforts and increased pressure from the State of Washington. We hope this will lead to the scheduling of additional clinic dates soon!

The clinic on January 20th will include Assisted Living residents and IL residents living in the Quinault. We were also able to obtain approximately 60 additional doses for other residents living in a congregate setting - this is enough to accommodate Chalet residents. Unfortunately, there are not enough doses to include Chinook residents at this time but we will get doses for them as soon as we can.

These changes necessitate another quick response from our team to ensure every available vaccine dose is used. Those eligible for this clinic as outlined in the previous paragraph will receive details today.

OFF-CAMPUS VACCINATION RESOURCES

While doses of the COVID-19 vaccine are still very limited and restricted to those currently eligible, we have heard reports of people receiving the vaccine at locations off campus. Specifically, we have heard from several residents who were successful in securing vaccine appointments with Kaiser. If you are eager to receive your first dose of the vaccine, check with your healthcare provider - they may have doses available.

Washington State Department of Health also has a website which lists several organizations in each county that **"may or may not have"** doses available.
