### CHANGES TO ROOM CAPACITY

Given the decrease in cases in our area and the county's recent move to the Governor's Phase 2, we believe now is an appropriate time to return our activity spaces to their previously approved maximum capacities.

**Effective Monday, February 22nd**, the maximum capacity for the activity spaces listed below will be as indicated. All other safety measures indicated in the proposals for each approved activity remain in place.

*\*For spaces with a maximum capacity of 1: Two members of the same household may use the space together as long as no one else is present.*
