STAFF MEMBER TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

A staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. This employee last worked on Friday, March 12th and developed symptoms over the weekend. They were tested on Tuesday, March 16th and received the positive result today, March 18th. The exposure did not occur on campus. The role of this employee does not involve in-person interaction with residents and all contact tracing has been completed.
