



Community Health Update - August 9, 2021

C&R EMPLOYEE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

The C&R received one positive employee result from the August 6th round of COVID-19 surveillance testing. This employee is asymptomatic and last worked today, before the positive result was received. They promptly left campus to isolate at home. At this time, the route of exposure for this employee is unknown but they did not have any interaction with the employees who tested positive last week.

All other results from the most recent round of testing have been received and they are negative. The C&R will continue to test all staff and residents every 3 to 7 days, as directed by the Thurston County Health Department. The next round of testing will begin tomorrow and we will keep the community informed if there are any additional positive results.

Outbreak Status restrictions remain in place, including:

- No on-site in-person visitation except for approved compassionate care visits. Residents may choose to have outings.
- No group activities or group dining.
- Residents are encouraged to stay in their room to the extent possible.
- New admissions aren't permitted. Readmissions are allowed with case by case review.
- Staff are following all infection control procedures including the use of face shields over an N95 mask at all times, and the addition of a gown and gloves when providing resident care.

COVID-19 TESTING FOR ASSISTED LIVING

As reported in the Community Health Update from August 5th, all Assisted Living residents and staff will be tested this week as an extra precaution.
