



Community Health Update - September 17, 2021

ADDITIONAL POSITIVE CASE IN THE C&R

One additional C&R resident has tested positive. They have been relocated to the designated COVID isolation unit.

As reported yesterday, we continue to follow the various guidelines and recommendations to stop the spread of COVID-19 as provided by the Washington State Department of Health (DOH), the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

We requested an Infection Control Risk Assessment to determine if there is anything we can do differently. This was conducted earlier this week and those present included the Thurston County Public Health Officer (Dr. Abdelmalek), the Thurston County Infection Prevention RN, and the Washington State DOH Nurse Consultant/Infection Preventionist/Healthcare Associated Infection RN. Their on-site investigation concluded that we are properly following all best practices to prevent transmission.
