

Community Health Update - October 22, 2021

TWO EMPLOYEES TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Employee Case #1:

The round of surveillance testing conducted on all C&R residents and staff Tuesday, October 19th returned one positive result for an employee. Due to recent changes in guidelines from state and local health authorities, the impacts on the C&R are different from what we have seen in the past.

- New admissions to the C&R may continue.
- The care area where this employee last worked will be on quarantine status for at least two rounds of surveillance testing. If the next two rounds of testing return all negative results for residents and employees, the vaccinated residents in the affected care area will return to normal activity. Unvaccinated residents will continue to quarantine for a 14 day period.
- The rest of the facility will continue with group activities, group dining, and visitation as permitted by the Washington State Department of Health Safe Start Plan for Longterm Care Facilities.

Employee Case #2:

One employee who does not work in the C&R or Assisted Living has tested positive for COVID-19. Contact tracing is complete and those affected have been notified.
